Session Minutes - December 21, 2017 - 1

NEW BUSINESS

1. Reverend Susan Arnold met with the leaders of the Boy Scout Troop who advised they will now be allowing girls to become members in compliance with national Boy Scout policies. Further, they would request use of the breakout rooms in the Echo Center to accommodate their expanding numbers.

MOTION - was made by Remica Gray and seconded by Charles Morgan to approve the use of the breakout rooms in the Echo Center for the Boy Scouts pending approval of the Youth. The motion passed.

- 2. Bonnie Judd addressed Session regarding the budget deficit and communication issues with the congregation.
- 3. Treasurer Maggie Morgan received a letter from a person who wanted to donate an amount of money to the church to a "donor defined account" meaning that the monies could not be used until written approval was given by the donor. The person desired a tax deduction for such gift which is in violation of Internal Revenue Service regulations as such a donation constitutes an "incomplete gift." and is not tax deductible.

Further, the Church's policy on such restricted gifts is as follows:

"Financial Policy #V.a. Receiving Money

a. The Session has ultimate authority over any monetary gifts to the church. A giver may specify a particular fund the money should go to (i.e. music fund, youth fund, etc.) but may not place any other limitation on the gift. If the giver wants to place other limitations on the gift, the Session has the right to refuse the gift."

After discussion, it was agreed by common consent that the gift be refused as restricted. Ms. Morgan will send a letter and a copy of the church's policy as stated above.
